**SITE INFORMATION**

NO private exercise pens or crates will be permitted in the building at the north end except small crates  
will be permitted in the area designated only when the breed is being judged and must be removed  
immediately after judging.

NO private exercise pens will be permitted under the grooming tent and crates must be stacked. Failure  
to do so will result in the committee ordering corrective measures and possible disciplinary action by  
the Event Committee.

Opening time of the building each morning will be posted in the judging schedule. No dogs may be left  
at the show site overnight.

**No chalking will be allowed inside the building. Grooming outdoors is available.**

Dogs are permitted only in designated areas of the fairgrounds. Please respect the off limit barriers. Clean  
up after your dogs. Future use of this site depends on keeping the grounds clean & in good condition.

All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries must be received by 5:00 pm EDT Wednesday, May 31 after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be returned.**

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after closing.

**Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds will be made, less \$5 per entry, for bitches entered in obedience who come into season after the closing date. A veterinarian certificate must be received by the Secretary within 7 days of the trial to obtain a refund.

**Fax/email entries:** Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to [secretary@caper-dogs.com](mailto:secretary@caper-dogs.com). Both sides of the entry form page must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to [www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm](http://www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm) and following the instructions there. **Payment must include the \$2.00 per class additional charge to be valid.**

**Online entries:** CAPER's online entry system will hopefully be functional before closing! See [www.caper-dogs.com](http://www.caper-dogs.com) for updates.

**Entry Errors:** Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

**Transfers to Best of Breed & higher Obedience or Jr Show classes:** Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Similarly, an entrant in a Novice Junior Showmanship can be transferred to Open and an Open entry can be moved to Masters. Obedience entries can be transferred to the next higher level in the given entered program. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of any judging for the show.

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## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

**Novice class:** For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

**Open class:** For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

The Novice & Open classes are divided (ages as of the day of the show):

- Novice & Open Junior - 9 years and under 12 years
- Novice & Open Intermediate - 12 years and under 15 years
- Novice & Open Senior - 15 years and under 18 years

**Master class:** For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

If entering a class with jumps, please list the dog's jump height on the entry form.

Transfers to the next higher level are allowed per the AKC rules and regulations. Refunds will be made, less \$5 per entry, for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date. A veterinarian certificate must be received by the Trial Secretary within 7 days of the trial to obtain a refund.

### 4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for Shetland Sheepdogs that are four months of age but under six months on the day of the event. An AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for each entry. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs/has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last 5 years.
- All entries must be received by the closing date. No entries will be taken at ringside.

Titles - The Certificate of Merit (CM) title is an introductory title to AKC conformation events. Entrants in each breed shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. Winners of the Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds or varieties will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their breed or variety. Winners of Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds or varieties will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their sex.

The Certificate of Merit requires 15 points awarded in accordance with the following points structure.

Dogs Competing – Points: 2 dogs: 1 pt • 4 dogs: 2 pts • 8 dogs: 3 pts • 12 dogs: 4 pts • 16 dogs: 5 pts
